DESCRIPTION: "Methylated Spirits" is ethyl alcohol which has been rendered non-potable by the addition of denaturants according to formulae prescribed in the Customs and Excise Act 1964 (Regulation R786 10th May, 1974). NCP Industrial Methylated Spirits is denatured according to the formula, Formula 5: to 95 volumes of industrial alcohol are added 3,5 volumes of Butanol, 1,5 volumes of benzine, Denatonium Benzoate, methyl violet/crystal violet dye .
