**DESCRIPTION:** "Methylated Spirits" is ethyl alcohol which has been rendered non-potable by the addition of denaturants according to formulae prescribed in the Customs and Excise Act 1964 (Regulation R786 10<sup>th</sup> May, 1974). NCP Industrial Methylated Spirits is denatured according to the formula, Formula 5: to 95 volumes of industrial alcohol are added 3,5 volumes of Butanol, 1,5 volumes of benzine, Denatonium Benzoate, methyl violet/crystal violet dye .
